- How do your ears feel when you hear LOUD sounds?





f stands for forte. Forte LOUD!




Let's clap really, really LOUDLY!

A horn speaker is a loud sound!




An alarm clock is a loud sound!


A bird chirping is a soft sound!

- You can create them using your imagination!




Pr Piano wants you to choose 2 soft sounds!

- You can create them using your imagination!


This will help us to create sound symphonies!

Symphonies are about working together to create!


Let's try a few of the sounds separately first.
