Dr Forte feels best when sounds are **LOUD!**


- How do you feel about **LOUD** sounds?

Your Dr Forte

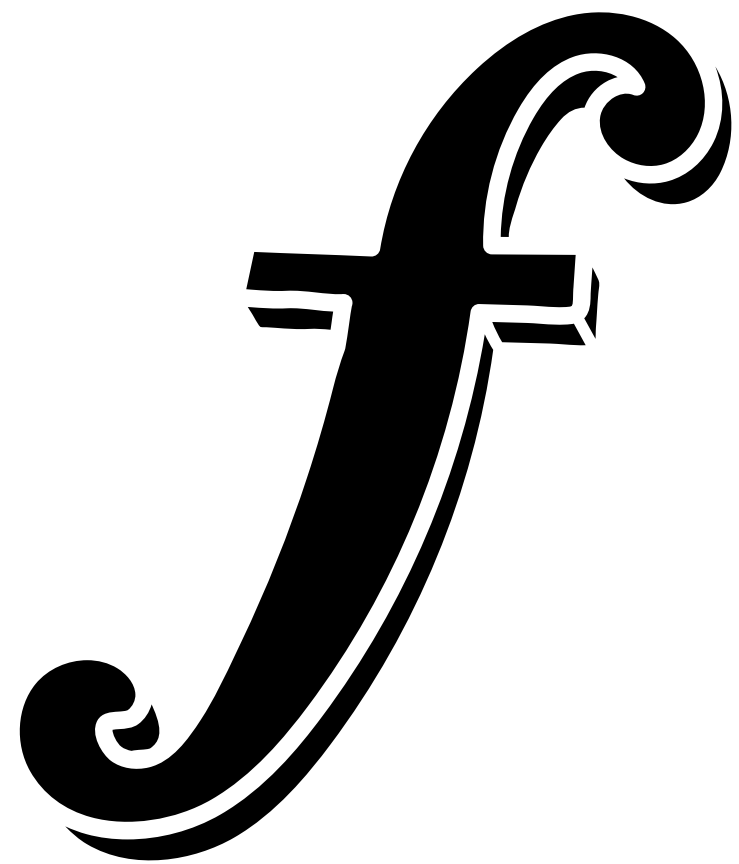
- Now you draw who you think Dr Forte should look like in the bubble on the left!

Doctor Forte together!



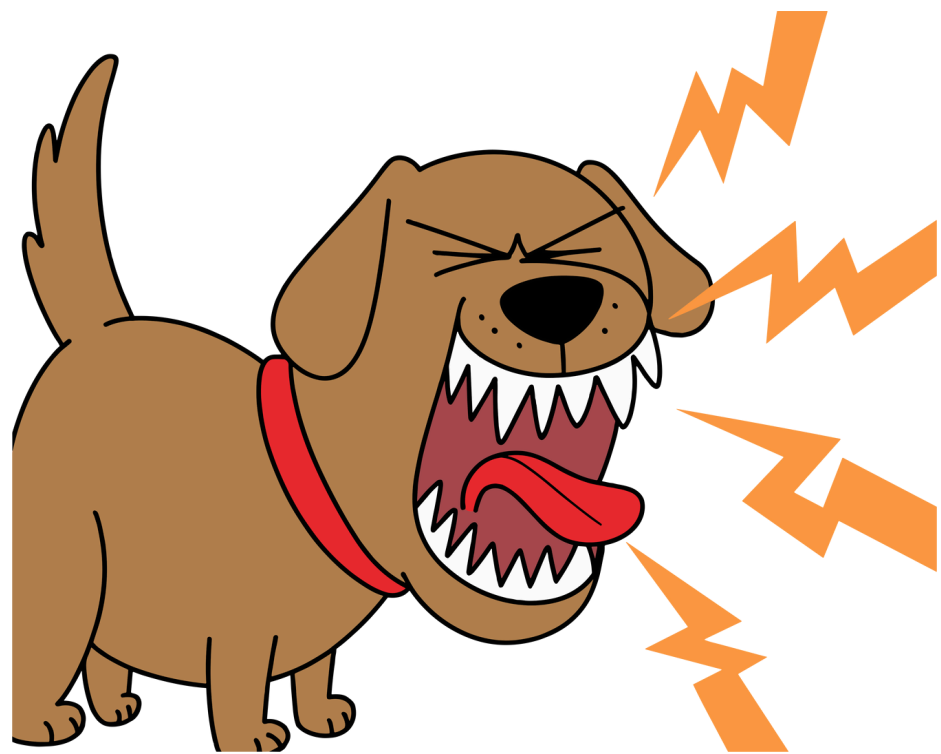

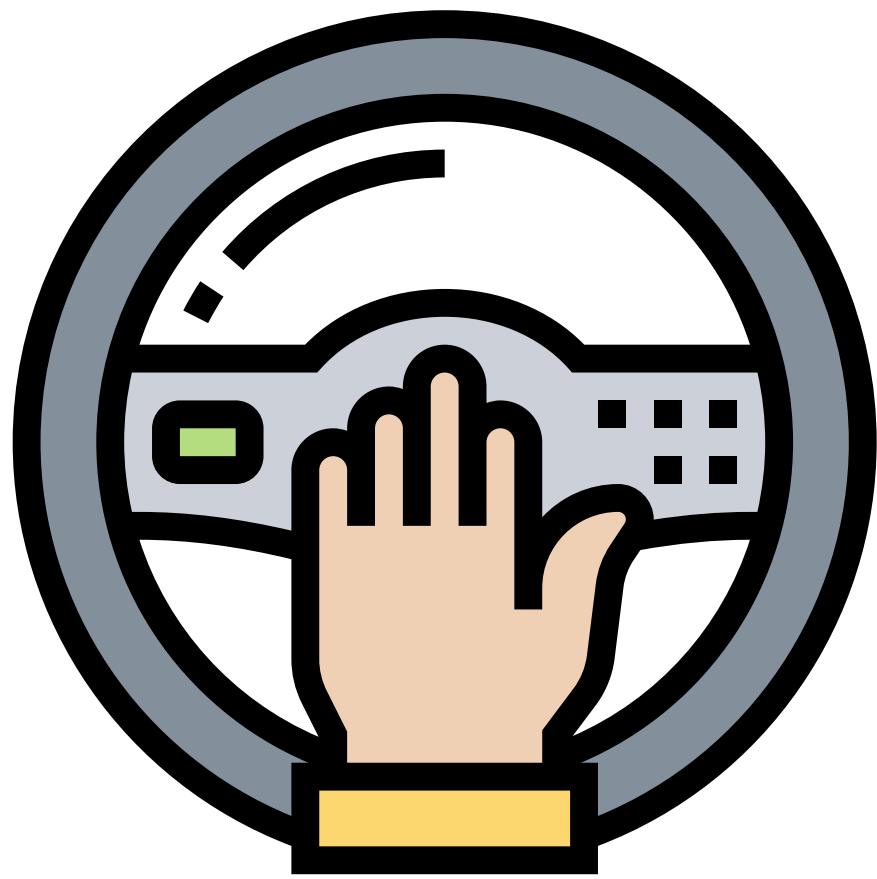

sound.... **wow!**

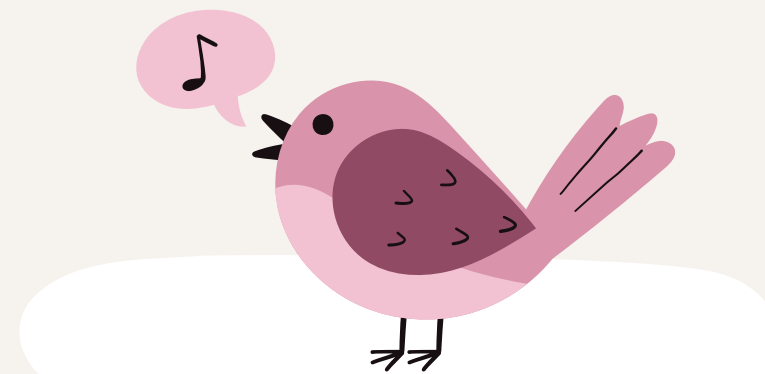


An alarm

What is a **soft** sound?

Let's listen!

A **soft** sound is hard to hear. It is pretty **quiet** - you have listen!



This is **Professor Piano**.
She likes very **soft** sounds.



- Wind is a **soft** sound.
Let's listen now!
- Lightly falling rain is a **soft** sound.
Let's listen now!
- Birds chirping is a **soft** sound.
Let's listen now!

Pr Piano feels best when sounds are soft.

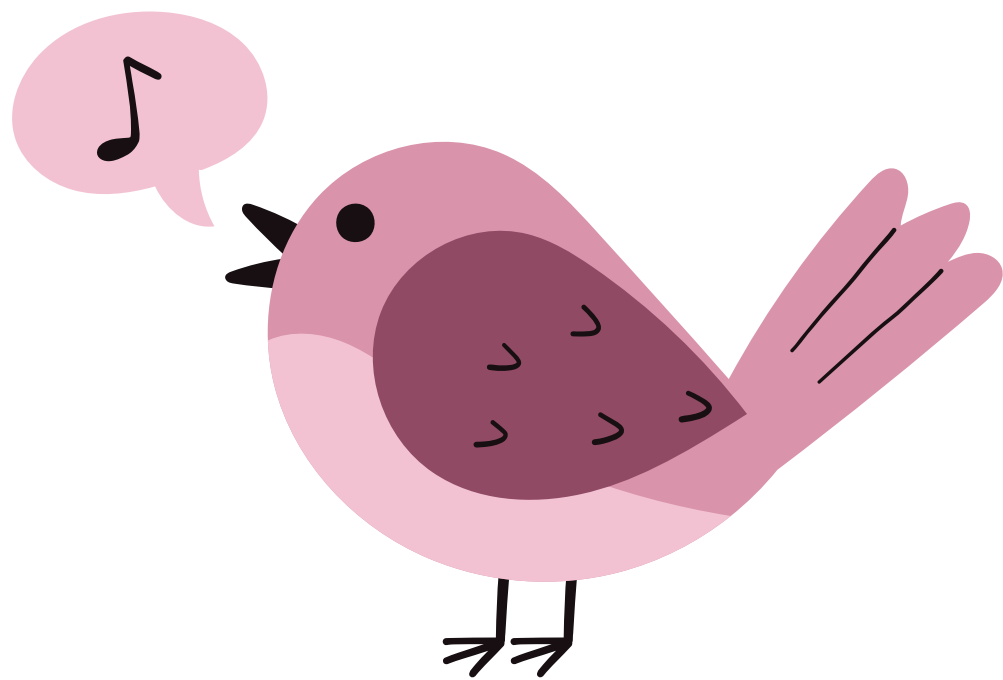

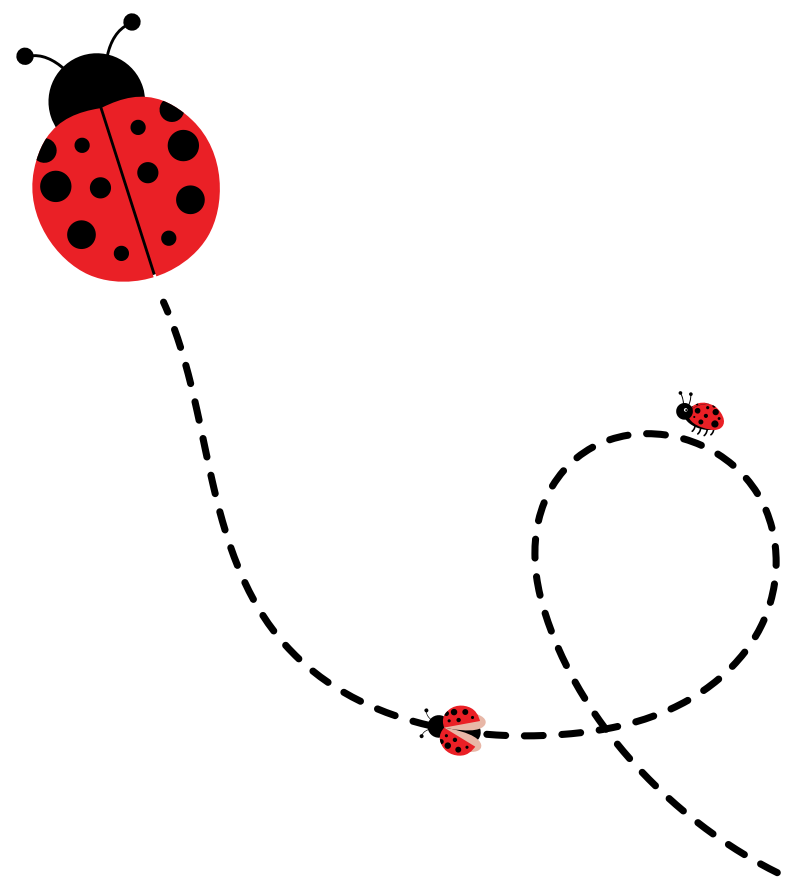
Listening is a

sound... **ssshhhh!**



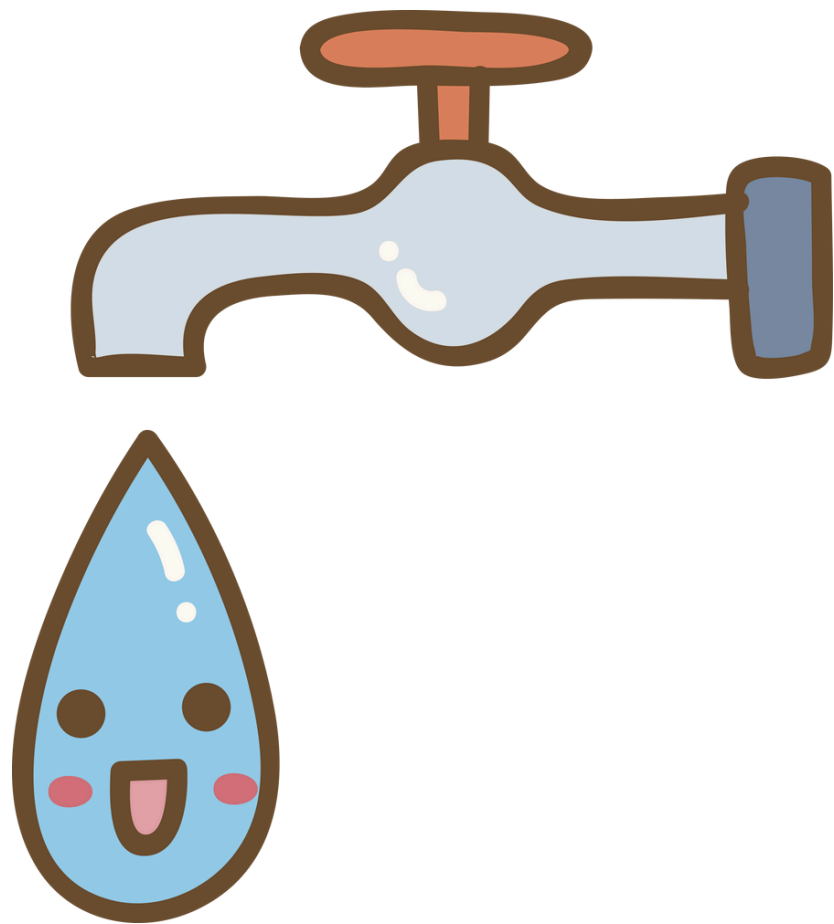
A clock

- You can create them using your imagination!



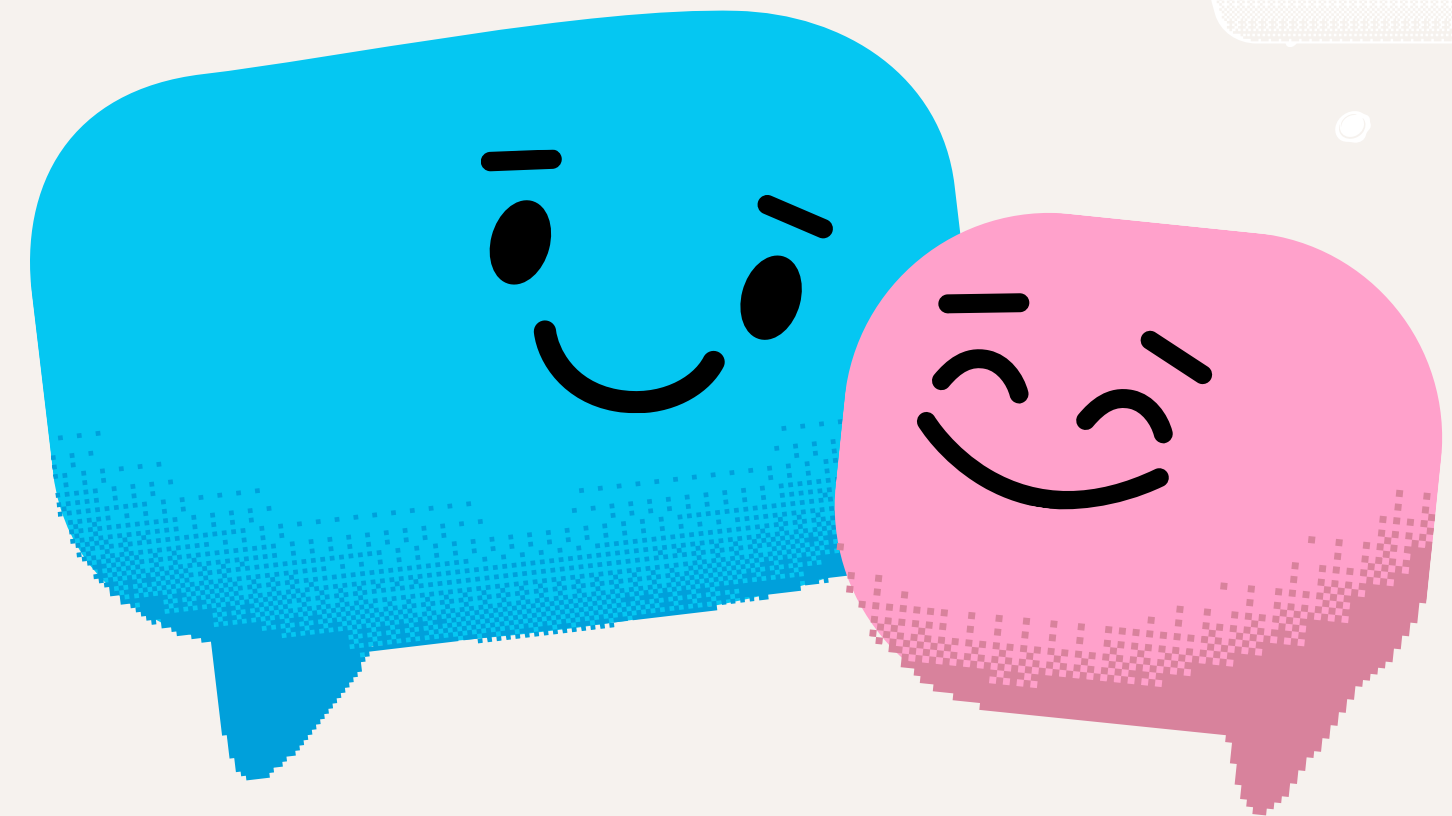
Pr Piano wants you to choose 2 **soft** sounds!

Let's try a few of the sounds separately first.

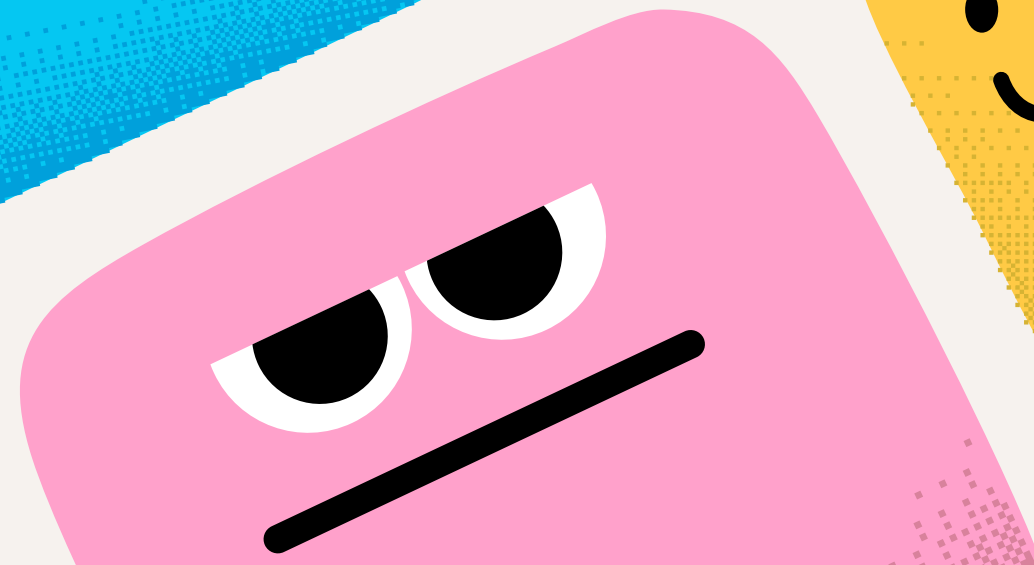
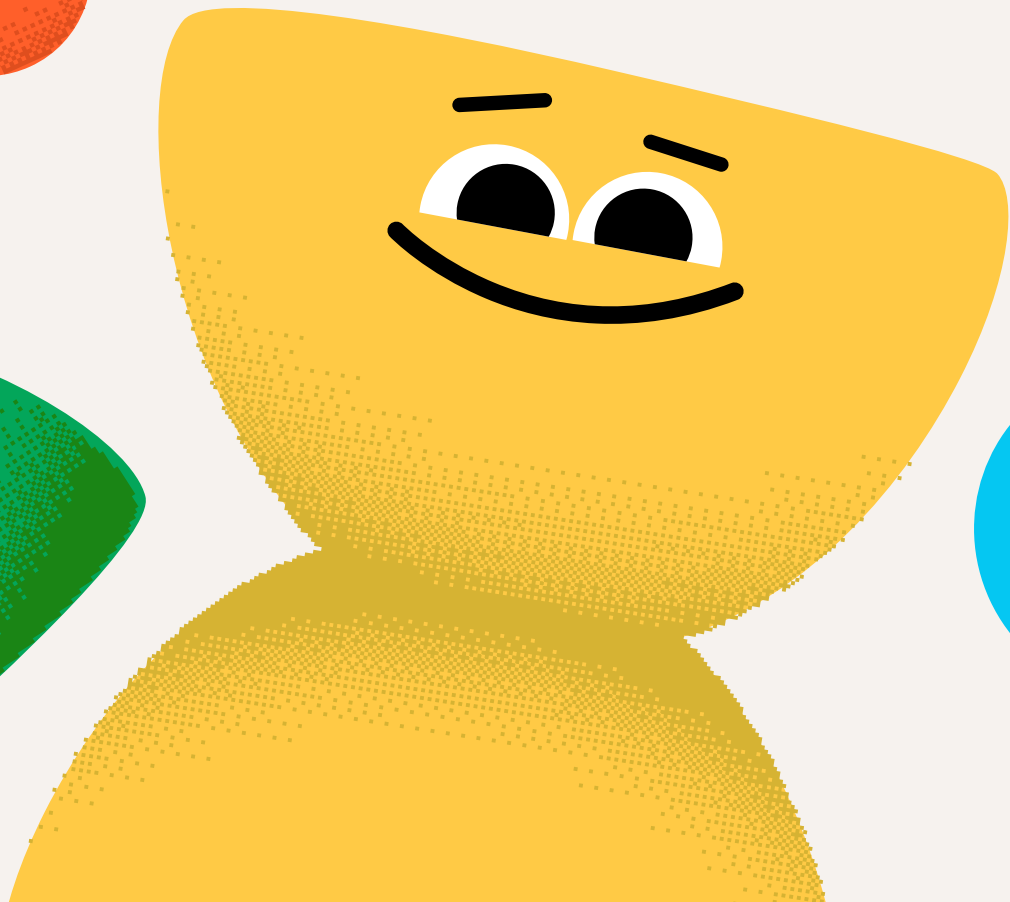
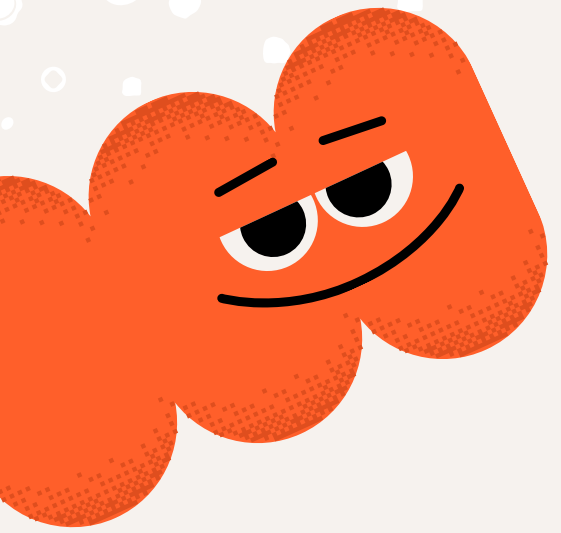
WHAT DOES IT SOUND LIKE?
